Discussion Questions

- Use some or all of these questions to facilitate discussion regarding this passage
1. In verse 1, what's Paul referring to as the "promise of the life that is in Christ Jesus?"  
What does this promise of life encompass?
  2. Absence has increased Paul's desire to fellowship with Timothy. How does our inability to gather corporately affect your desire to see the saints at FBC?
  3. Constant prayer was part of Paul's love for Timothy, how can you apply this example to your spiritual walk and community of faith at FBC in these times especially?
  4. How can you apply the truth of verse 7 to your life right now? What does that tangibly look like in real life for you?
  5. Where does Paul (ever the teacher) remind Timothy of the gospel message in this passage?
  6. What are the main tenants of the gospel as Paul outlines here?
  7. How do verses 9-10 give you hope in general and especially in our current world and national climate?

8. What do you learn about God from this passage? What do you learn about the work of Jesus and the plight of humanity in light of this passage?

1. For God to use this current world situation to increase his glory and fame and majesty
2. For local churches to be salt and light as they display trust in Christ rather than anxiety during this tenuous time
3. That this world situation would cause many who stand opposed to Christ to repent of their sin and trust in him as Lord and Savior and only hope in life or death
4. That humility, prayer, and reliance on God would increase within the church and that selfishness and self-reliance would decrease
5. That Christians who are unable to gather as local churches would lament that reality and long for their church family
6. That loving our neighbors as ourselves would be done in tangible and visible ways
7. Wisdom for national and local leaders as they make weighty decisions in an attempt to curb the spread of COVID-19
