Anápolis , Brazil

We were able to have a two week counseling session in May amid the COVID-19 pandemic. It was a God thing. Within one week the Lord spoke to 5 different couples and they all drove here from 3 different states- very few flights available. God really worked in supernatural power to do healing. We worked with a reduced number of staff, due to 4 older members and afraid of getting the coronavirus. So, because of no income in April, and due to the state government saying we could have only 65% of maximum capacity, we are about US\$2700 in the red. We are now in the middle of the June counseling two week period and have 2 couples and 3 singles. We thank the Lord for His sovereign provision!



Our mayor of Anápolis has opened up everything, which started three weeks ago. Two other cities in our state are still shut down: urban centers which have had more virus cases. São Paulo, Belo Horizonte, Rio de Janeiro, Manaus and Fortaleza are the cities which are still having a significant number of deaths. However, where we are there have been only 8 deaths attributed to the coronavirus. So, we thank the Lord for His sovereign protection.

Please continue to pray for the health of our staff members, and Kathy and I as well. We are planning to have two two week counseling periods in the month of July, which is double what we normally do. The dates are June 29th to July 10th, and July 20th to July 31st. Ask God to intervene in the lives of those who are coming. They are having difficulty in finding flights or bus tickets to arrive here at Oásis.
